

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to recommend:

*Res. 96 1008/37*

THAT under authority of Section 2, Chapter 189, Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1924, Lot Three hundred and sixty-two (362) in a subdivision of Lot Two thousand four hundred and fifty "S" (2450-S), Similkameen District be reserved and set aside for a Provincial Park.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND that in conformity with the provisions of Sections 3 and 5 of said Act, the following be appointed a board in and for the locality comprised within Lot Three hundred and sixty-two (362) of Lot Two thousand four hundred and fifty "S" (2450-S), Similkameen District, to be called the "Oliver Provincial Park Board" to manage, regulate and control the said park during pleasure:
