The undersigned has the honour to report:

RES. 227/61

THAT the following described lands have been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public.

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Indian Reserve No. 20, Nazko, Cariboo District; thence South along the West boundary of Indian Reserve No. 20 a distance of 20 chains; thence West 10 chains; thence North 20 chains to the South boundary of Lot 2150, Cariboo District; thence East along the south boundary of Lot 2150 to the point of commencement and containing 20 acres more or less.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Nazko Community Park.
