THAT placer mining in the vicinity of Barkerville was a significant factor in the early development of British Columbia;

AND THAT Barkerville Townsite is representative of an historic era in the growth of the Province;

AND THAT, during "Centennial Year" the British Columbia Centennial Committee has acquired, on behalf of the Queen in right of the Province, certain historic lands and buildings within Barkerville Townsite;

AND THAT it is fitting that said, and other, historic lands and buildings be preserved for the enjoyment, edification and inspiration of the people of the Province.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act" all Crown lands within the following described boundaries be constituted a Provincial park to be known as Barkerville Historic Park:

Commencing at the north-east corner of Lot 10371, "Highland Lassie" Mineral Claim, Cariboo District; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said Lot 10371 "Highland Lassie" Mineral Claim to the easterly boundary of Lot 7566; thence in a general southerly direction along the said easterly boundary of Lot 7566 to the south-east corner thereof; thence south-westerly along the south-easterly boundary of Lot 7566 and the north-westerly boundary of Lot 7531 to the most westerly corner of said Lot 7531; thence south-westerly in a straight line to the most northerly corner of Lot 10389 "Progress No. 6" Mineral Claim; thence southerly, westerly and south-easterly along the boundaries of said Lot 10389 "Progress No. 6" Mineral Claim to the north-west corner of "Aurora Company" Mining Claim No. C.G.47^F; thence south-westerly in a straight line to the most southerly corner of Lot 10516 "Venus Fraction" Mineral Claim; thence south-westerly in a straight line to Post C on the southerly boundary of "Wintrip" Mining Claim No. C.G.32^F; thence South 43° East a distance of 240 feet

more or less to the north-westerly boundary of "Black Jack" Mining Claim No. C.G.1^A; thence north-easterly along the north-westerly boundary of said "Black Jack" Mining Claim No. C.G.1^B to the most northerly corner thereof; thence south-easterly, south-westerly, south-easterly and north-easterly along the boundaries of Lot 10503 "Diller" Mineral Claim to the most northerly corner of Lot 10469 "Black Jack Extension" Mineral Claim; thence north-easterly in a straight line to the most northerly corner of "United Company" Mining Claim No. C.G. 48^F; thence north-easterly in a straight line to a point on the south-westerly boundary of aforesaid Lot 10389 "Progress No. 6" Mineral Claim North 66° 9' West a distance of 420 feet from the most southerly corner thereof; thence south-easterly, north-easterly and north-westerly along the boundaries of said Lot 10389 "Progress No. 6" Mineral Claim to the westerly boundary of Lot 10901 "Garry No. 3 Fraction" Mineral Claim; thence northerly along the said westerly boundary of Lot 10901 "Garry No. 3 Fraction" Mineral Claim to the southerly boundary of "Independent" Mining Claim No. C.G.31^F; thence easterly, northerly and westerly along the southerly, easterly and northerly boundaries of the said "Independent" Mining Claim No. C.G. 31^F to the south-west corner of "Forest Rose Company" Mining Claim No. C.G. 33^F; thence northerly along the said westerly boundary of "Forest Rose Company" Mining Claim No. C.G. 33^F to the south-east corner of "Bawden" Mining Claim No. C.G. 26^F; thence northerly and westerly along the easterly and northerly boundaries of said "Bawden" Mining Claim No. C.G.26^F to the north-west corner thereof; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of aforesaid Lot 10371 "Highland Lassie" Mineral Claim to the north-east corner thereof, being the point of commencement, comprising 160 acres more or less.

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT the said Barkerville Historic Park shall be of Class "A".
