The undersigned has the honour to Report:


THAT the following described Crown lands have been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public:

Lot 104, Victoria District, containing 208 acres.


AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes;
