The undersigned has the honour to recommend;-

Cancelled of 1434/46

THAT under authority of Section 2, Chapter 189, Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1924, Lots 594 and 596, Group 2, New Westminster District, be reserved and set aside for park purposes, on the understanding that the Crown shall not be responsible for the maintenance, upkeep or any liability or expense whatever in connection therewith.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND that in conformity with the provisions of Sections 3 and 5 of said Act, the following be appointed a Board in and for the locality comprised within Lots 594 and 596, Group 2, New Westminster District, to be called the White Rock Provincial Park Board to manage, regulate and control the Provincial Park hereby reserved, during pleasure.
