The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT Lot A, of District Lot 219, Osoyoos Division of the Yale District, Plan 6755, was reserved and set aside as Kelowna Provincial Park by Order-in-Council No. 1355, approved June 4th, 1955.

AND THAT the boundaries of Kelowna Provincial Park were extended to include Lots 40 and 41, Block 23, Osoyoos Division of the Yale District, Map 1306, by Order-in-Council No. 1040, approved May 3rd, 1957.

AND THAT the Corporation of the City of Kelowna has requested the said Lot A, District Lot 219, Plan 6755, and Lots 40 and 41, Block 23, Map 1306, all of Osoyoos Division of the Yale District, be made available for management by the Corporation of the City of Kelowna as a city park.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, Kelowna Provincial Park be cancelled.
