

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:


The undersigned has the honour to recommend;

RES. 426/76

THAT under authority of Section 127 of the Forest Act as enacted by the Forest Act Amendment Act, 1939, the following described parcels of land which were reserved and set apart for the recreation and enjoyment of the public by authority of Order in Council No. 1626 approved on the 24th November, 1939, be constituted a Provincial Park for the pleasure and recreation of the public to be known as "Elk River Park."

"Lots "A" and "B" 1, Lot 5455, Kootenay District, Registered Plan 1613, together with that tract of land consisting of an island, or islands, situated in the Elk River and lying immediately to the east of the south half of Lot 5455, Kootenay District, and excepting thereout the right of way of the C.N.S. Railway."
