THAT the following described lands have been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public.

That part of Fractional Legal Subdivision 14, of Section 24, Township 21, Range 8, W6M, lying east of the right-of-way of the Canadian Pacific Railway and containing 9.6 acres more or less.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Mara Point Park.
