Pursuant to the PARK Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS Order-in-Council 1423, approved May 19, 1964, established Peace Island Class 'C' Provincial Park over the following described lands:

Unsurveyed Island in Sections 25 & 26, and fractional L.S. 4 of Section 25, all in Township 82, Range 18, W6M, containing 102 acres, more or less.

AND WHEREAS the following described lands were added to Peace Island Class 'C' Provincial Park by Order-in-Council 752, approved March 8, 1968:

That part of Block 'B' of Legal Subdivision 7 lying east of the gazetted width of the Alaska Highway and Block 'B' and 'C' of Legal Subdivision 8 of Section 25, Township 82, Range 18, W6M, Peace River District, save and excepting the West Coast Transmission Line Right-of-Way, Plan C.G. 844, containing 1.77 acres, more or less.

AND WHEREAS it is considered to be in the public interest to transfer the administration and control of Peace Island Park to the Village of Taylor;

Peace Island Class 'C' Provincial Park be cancelled.
