The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT under the provisions of Section 2 of Chapter 211 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936, Block "A", Lot Two Hundred and Ninety-three (293) of Lot Two Thousand Four Hundred and Fifty "S" (2450-S), Similkameen Division of Yale District, was reserved and set aside as a Provincial Park known as Testalinda Park, by Order-in-Council No. 1139, approved August 19th, 1939;

AND THAT the said Testalinda Provincial Park was classified as a Provincial Park of Class "C" by Order-in-Council No. 1660, approved December 14th, 1940;

AND THAT the said Testalinda Provincial Park has not been developed or used for the purpose for which it was reserved and set aside;

AND THAT the above-described lands are now considered unsuitable and unneeded for park purposes;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT pursuant to Section 128 of the "Forest Act", being Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, Testalinda Provincial Park be hereby cancelled;

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT a certified copy of this minute, if approved, be forwarded to the Superintendent of Lands, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C.


