The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

1881/79, 1254/85, 611/86

THAT the following described areas have been examined and found suitable for Park purposes.

- (1) Block 12 of Lot 2883^S, Similkameen Division of the Yale District as shown on plan 4597 deposited with the Kamloops Land Registry Office, and containing 3.99 acres more or less.
- (2) Commencing at a point on the westerly limit of Highway No. 3, being 10 chains south and 9.5 chains east of the north west corner of Lot 1012 Similkameen Division Yale District; thence westerly parallel to the north boundary of Lot 1012 to the left bank of Boundary Creek; thence northerly and easterly along the said left bank of Boundary Creek to its intersection with the north boundary of the aforesaid Lot 1012; thence in an easterly direction along the said north boundary to its intersection with the aforesaid westerly limit of Highway No. 3; thence in a southerly direction along the said westerly limit to the point of commencement: Save and except therefrom the right-of-way of the south Kootenay Water Power Company. Containing 7 acres more or less. *Assess % 1249/60*
- (3) The most northerly 10 chains of Lot 3980, Range 5 Coast Land District, lying south of the south boundary of Lot 2702 C.R. 5; containing 11 acres more or less. *AMM 0/C 408/71*
- (4) The west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the south east $\frac{1}{4}$ of Lot 229, Similkameen Division of the Yale District, save and except Block "A", Plan B 3224, on deposit with the Kamloops Land Registry Office, and containing 57.5 acres more or less. *Assess % 110/62*
- (5) The east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the fractional south west $\frac{1}{4}$ of D.L. 2814, Lillooet District, containing 53.6 acres, more or less. *0/C 2514/56*
- (6) Lot 926 of D.L. 2450^S, Similkameen Division of Yale District as shown on plan 6070 on deposit in the Kamloops Land Registry Office, and containing 7 acres, more or less. *AMM 0/C 1534/10*
- (7) Lot 11775, Cariboo Land District, containing 100.00 acres, more or less.
- (8) The south $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 8996, Kootenay District, containing 57.34 acres. *AMM % 2744/63*

AND THAT because of their present and intended development and use, as units in the Provincial Road, and Lakeside camp and picnic site system, it is advisable to administer them as Provincial parks of Class "A".

✓ AND TO RECOMMEND THAT in accordance with the provisions of Section 128 of the "Forest Act", being Chapter 128, "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948", the previously described areas be constituted Provincial Parks, to be known respectively, as: (1) Okanagan Falls Park, (2) Boundary Creek Park, (3) Lakelse Lake Park, (4) Johnstone Creek Park, (5) Lac La Hache Park, (6) Inkaneep Park, (7) Bijoux Falls Park, (8) Dry Gulch Park.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT in accordance with the provisions of Section 129 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128, "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948", the said parks shall be of Class "A".

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT a certified copy of this minute, if approved, be forwarded to the Superintendent of Lands, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C.
