THAT the administrators of the estate of the late Alexander McDonald of Sidney, B.C., have conveyed title to certain lands to the Crown for the recreation of the public.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT in accordance with the provisions of Section 127 of the "Forest Act" and Amendments, Lot 5, of Sections 17 and 18, Range 2, East, North Saanich District, Plan 6606, containing 5 acres more or less, be created a Provincial Park to be known as "McDonald Provincial Park".

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT in accordance with the provisions of Section 128 of the "Forest Act" and Amendments, McDonald Provincial Park be classified as a Class "A" Provincial Park.
