To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to recommend:-

THAT under the authority of Section 2, of the "Provincial Parks Act", Chapter 187, Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1911, all vacant and unalienated Crown lands, being portion of the New Westminster Land District, situate within the following described boundaries, be reserved for park purposes; namely,

COMMENCING at a point in the centre of the stream of Cheakamus River being due West of the North-west corner of Lot 3033, New Westminster District; thence East to the said North-west corner of Lot 3033 and continuing due East to the East boundary of Lot 2882, New Westminster District, thence South to the North-east corner of Lot 513, thence East a distance of fourteen miles; thence North seven miles; thence East four miles; thence North to a point in the centre of the stream of Cheakamus River near its headwaters, thence Westerly along the centre of the stream of said river to Cheakamus Lake, thence Westerly along the highwater mark on the South shore of said Lake to its outlet, thence down stream along the centre of the stream of Cheakamus River to the point of commencement.

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND that this Reserve shall also apply to any lands within the described area which at the present time are covered by Timber Licence or other incomplete alienation, in the event of same lapsing or becoming void; except such portions of said lands as might be deemed suitable for settlement.
