THAT under the authority of Sub-section 1 of Section 2 of the "Provincial Parks Act", being Chapter 211, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936, the following described area be reserved and set apart as a Provincial Park to be known as Brentwood Bay Park:

"All that area of foreshore, or lands covered by water, and being that part of Brentwood Bay which fronts on Sections 10, 11 and 12, Range 2 West, South Saanich District, the said area extending seaward from high-water mark, and which lies between the westerly extension of the south boundary of Josephine Road and the westerly extension of the north boundary of Section 10, Range 2 West, in the above mentioned South Saanich District, save and excepting thereout District Lots 154, 155, 156, 235 and 239, Cowichan District."
