The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council 2814, approved December 1, 1958, Beaver Harbour Park Class C, was established under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, being Chapter 53, Statutes of British Columbia, 1957, and that by Order-in-Council 767 approved April 13, 1959, certain foreshore in the amount of 62.4 acres adjacent to the park were added;

AND THAT the above described lands have now been surveyed as Lot 1 of the northeast quarter of Section 21 and northwest quarter of Section 22 and the fractional southeast quarter of Section 28, all in Township 6 Rupert District, Plan 22815;

AND THAT the District of Port Hardy has expressed a desire to obtain this park for community purposes;

AND THAT these lands are considered to be of greater significance for a community park than for a Provincial park;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Park Act, Beaver Harbour Park be cancelled.
