The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

CANCELLED 2280/82

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 556, dated April 14, 1943, "All that part of Lot 13G, Oyster District, which lies between Bush Creek and the V.L. & M. Company's old railway right-of-way, containing 40 acres more or less," was reserved and set apart for the recreation and enjoyment of the public, notice of which was published in the B.C. Gazette dated April 14, 1943, to be administered by the Corporation of the City of Ladysmith;

THAT the said area was surveyed as Lot No. 24G, Oyster District, 32.04 acres;

THAT the said Lot 24G has been released from the administration of the Corporation of the City of Ladysmith to the Crown for incorporation as a Provincial Park;

AND TO RECOMMEND:

*o/c 1115/55 3005/57,*

THAT under authority of Section 96 of the "Land Act", Chapter 175, R.S.B.C., 1948, the reserve placed on the above described parcel of land be cancelled;

THAT under authority of Section 128 of the "Forest Act", being Chapter 128, R.S.B.C., 1948, the said Lot No. 24G, Oyster District, be constituted a Provincial Park for the pleasure and recreation of the public, to be known as "Ivy Green Park";

THAT under authority of Section 128 of the "Forest Act", being Chapter 128, R.S.B.C., 1948, the following described parcels of land, being vacant Crown lands, also be constituted as part of said "Ivy Green Park":

Lot 25G and Lot 27G, both of Oyster District.

The whole park containing 49.73 acres, more or less.

AND THAT under authority of Section 129 of the "Forest Act", being Chapter 128, R.S.B.C., 1948, the said Park be classified as a Provincial Park of Class "A".
