The undersigned has the honour to recommend;

THAT under authority of Subsection 1 of Section 2 of the "Provincial Parks Act", being Chapter 211, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936, the Fractional South West quarter of Section 27, Township 20, Range 8, West Sixth Meridian, containing 14.6 acres and situated at Mara Lake, be reserved and set apart as a Provincial Park to be known as Mara Recreation Park.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND that under authority of Section 3 of the "Provincial Parks Act", the following Board be appointed to manage, regulate and control the said park, to be called the Mara Provincial Park Board:


