

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT under authority of Order-in-Council Number 1684, approved 31st December, 1938, the north half and south-east quarter of Section 49, Salt Spring Island was reserved and set aside as Mount Bruce Provincial Park;

AND TO FURTHER REPORT THAT under authority of Order-in-Council Number 1660, approved December 14th, 1940, the said Mount Bruce Park was reclassified as a Provincial Park of Class "C";

AND TO FURTHER REPORT THAT the said lands are now considered unsuitable for park purposes;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 128 of the "Forest Act", being Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the said Mount Bruce Park be cancelled.
