The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report

THAT by notice dated 3rd August, 1904, and published in the British Columbia Gazette of the 4th August, 1904, Kaien Island situated in Range 5, Coast District, was reserved for Government purposes until further notice.

THAT portion of Kaien Island was subsequently granted to the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway Company and the remainder is still in the Reserve above referred to.

THAT a portion of the existing Reserve is now required for industrial purposes and has been surveyed and designated Lot 6535, Range 5, Coast District, containing 15.3 acres.

AND TO RECOMMEND that under authority of Section 130, Chapter 129, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1911, the reserve existing over the said Lot 6535, Range 5, Coast District, be cancelled.
