THAT the following described lands have been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public by Order-in-Council No. 681, approved March 21, 1958.

Lot 5092, Osoyoos Division, Yale District, containing 3.37 acres, subject however to a right-of-way in favour of the Okanagan Water Power Company and also subject to final Water Licence No. 14185, dated December 1st, 1950, or any other water licence hereafter issued in substitution thereof for the licence under such final or other substituted water licence to enter upon the lands reserved and to maintain, repair and operate thereon and therein the works authorized at the date of this reserve under the said final water licence.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT Order-in-Council No. 681, approved March 21, 1958 be cancelled.

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Mission Beach Park.




