To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT under authority of Order-in-Council Number 1305, approved 13th. October, 1933, the undermentioned area was reserved and set aside as Lockhart Beach Park.

"Commencing at the point of intersection of high-water-mark of the easterly shore of Kootenay Lake with high-water-mark of the southerly bank of Lockhart Creek; thence in an easterly direction following said high-water-mark of the southerly bank of Lockhart Creek to the point thereon which lies at a distance of Three Hundred and fifteen (315) feet, measured easterly in a right line from the above defined point of commencement; thence on a bearing of S. 1° 34' W for a distance of Four Hundred and forty (440) feet; thence on a bearing of S. 51° 27' W for a distance of Two Hundred and Sixty-six (266) feet, more or less, to high-water-mark of the easterly shore of Kootenay Lake aforesaid; thence in a general northerly direction along said high-water-mark to the point of commencement, but excepting thereout of the above-described area the Sixty-six (66) feet right-of-way of the Trans-Provincial Highway as now located and surveyed, and containing a net area of Four and Nine-tenths (4.9) acres, more or less."

AND TO FURTHER REPORT THAT under authority of Order-in-Council Number 1660, approved December 14th. 1940, the said Lockhart Beach Park was reclassified as a Provincial Park of Class "C".

AND TO FURTHER REPORT THAT the said lands are now considered unsuitable for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 128 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the said Lockhart Beach Park be cancelled.
