The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

o/c 2275/65

THAT the following described lands which are now under the administration of the British Columbia Department of Agriculture, are no longer required for agricultural purposes:

That part of the unsubdivided portion of Sub Lot 28, District Lot 4598, Kootenay Land District, bounded on the west by the easterly limit of Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way, and bounded on the east by the westerly limit of the West Kootenay Power and Light Company's power line right-of-way, excepting thereout the right-of-way for the Southern Trans-Provincial Highway, and containing 300 acres more or less.

THAT the said lands have been examined and found to have high recreational values and are needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act," being Chapter 53, Statutes of British Columbia, 1957, that the above-described lands be created a Provincial Park of Class "A" to be known as Brilliant Terrace Park.
