SCHEDULE

ANDREW BAY PARK

All Crown land and land covered by water within Range 4 Coast District contained within the area described as:

Commencing at a point on the 2900 foot contour, said point lying 2.15 km west and 700 m south, more or less, from the northwest corner of District Lot 1202, as shown on NTS Map 93 E/15, Edition 1;

thence due South 450 m;

thence Westerly along the northerly natural boundary of Ootsa Lake, as shown on said NTS Map a distance of 1 km;

thence due North 450 m, more or less to the 2900 foot contour;

thence in a general Easterly direction along said contour to the point of commencement.
