The undersigned has the honour to report: Res. 1291/91

THAT the following described lands were acquired by the Crown on the recommendation of the Game Commission for use in rearing fish:

Lot M, as shown on Plan of Subdivision
1920 on deposit in the Kamloops Land
Registry Office.

THAT these lands are now no longer required by the Game Commission.

AND THAT local need and desire for a community park in this region can be accommodated by these lands.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 13 of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act", being Chapter 53, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1957, the lands described in the foregoing be constituted a Provincial park to be known as "Sutherland Hills Park."

FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 14 of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act," being Chapter 53, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, the said Sutherland Hills Park shall be of Class "C".
