Pursuant to the Park Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS the following described Crown Lands have been examined and found suitable for Park purposes:

All that parcel or tract of land, situated in Kamloops Division of Yale District more particularly known and described as:

Fractional southwest 1/4, Section 31, Township 17, Range 13, West of the sixth Meridian, as shown on Plan "B" 691, Kamloops Land Registry office, and containing approximately 3.3 acres.

THE ABOVE DESCRIBED CROWN LANDS be designated as a Class A Provincial Park to be known as Westwold Park.

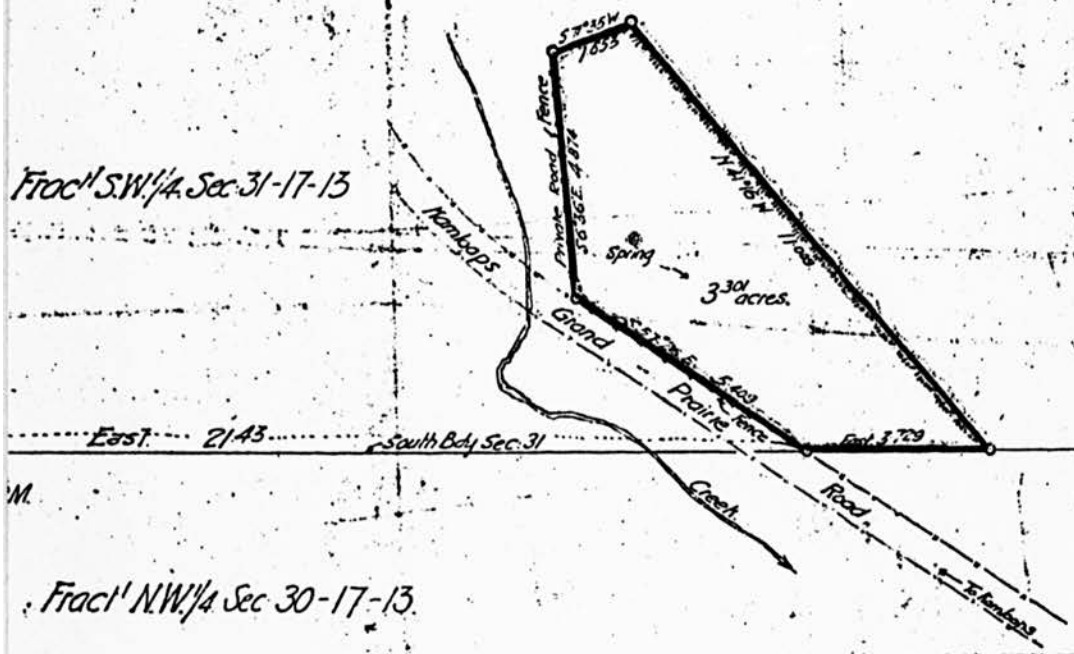
