



Schedule

1. ✓ The name of Andrew Bay Park, a Class "A" Provincial Park, established by Order in Council 1028/90, is amended to be **Andrews Bay Park**.
2. ✓ Blackcomb Glacier Park, established by Order in Council 1202/90, is cancelled and the Crown land in the Blackcomb Glacier Park schedule is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name is declared to be Blackcomb Glacier Park. ✓
3. ✓ F.H. Barber Park, re-established by Order in Council 1345/82, is cancelled and the Crown land in the F.H. Barber Park schedule is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name is declared to be F.H Barber Park. ✓
4. ✓ Gabriola Sands Park, re-established by Order in Council 393/89, is cancelled and the Crown land in the Gabriola Sands Park schedule is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name is declared to be Gabriola Sands Park. ✓
5. ✓ The description of Green Lake Islands site of Green Lake Park, re-established by Order in Council 392/89, is repealed and replaced with the Green Lake Islands Site schedule.
6. ✓ The name of Lake Revelstoke Park (Martha Creek site), a Class "A" Provincial Park, established by Order in Council 793/93, is amended to be **Martha Creek Park**.
7. ✓ Raft Cove Park, established by Order in Council 365/90, is cancelled and the Crown land in the Raft Cove Park schedule is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name is declared to be Raft Cove Park. ✓
8. ✓ Rugged Point Park, re-established by Order in Council 1418/90, is cancelled and the Crown land in the Rugged Point Marine Park schedule is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name is declared to be **Rugged Point Marine Park**. ✓
9. ✓ Shannon Falls Park, re-established by Order in Council 1418/90, is cancelled and the Crown land in the Shannon Falls Park schedule is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name is declared to be Shannon Falls Park. ✓
10. ✓ Taylor Arm Park, re-established by Order in Council 1183/89, is cancelled and the Crown land in the Taylor Arm Park schedule is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name is declared to be Taylor Arm Park. ✓

BLACKCOMB GLACIER PARK

Schedule

All those parcels or tracts of Crown land, together with all that foreshore or land covered by water situated in Group 1, New Westminster District and lying within the following described boundaries:

Commencing at a point, said point being 5.5 km due East of the northeast corner of District Lot 4750;

thence due East, 250 metres;

thence Southeast in a straight line 2.50 km, more or less, to a point, said point lying 400 m due North of the Spearhead Peak, as shown on the second edition of the N.T. S. Map 92J/2;

thence southerly, 920 metres to a point lying 520 metre due South of Spearhead Peak;

thence due West, 850 metres;

thence due North, 1 km;

thence due West, 220 metres;

thence due North, 370 metres;

thence due West, 130 metres;

thence due North, 325 metres;

thence due West, 100 metres, more or less to a point due south of the point of commencement;

thence due North, 1.5 km, more or less, to the point of commencement.

The whole containing approximately 250 hectares.

F.H. BARBER PARK

Schedule

All those parcels or tracts of Crown land, together with all that foreshore or land covered by water situated in New Westminster District and lying within the following described boundaries:

- 1) That part of the fractional north 1/2 of the southwest quarter of Section 19, Township 4, Range 27, West of the 6th Meridian, lying to the East of the Fraser River and to the West of Plan A718.
- 2) That part of the south 1/2 of the southwest quarter of Section 19, Township 4, Range 27, West of the 6th Meridian, bounded on the West by the left bank of the Fraser River and the west boundary of said quarter section and on the East by the west boundary of Plan 25402AK.
- 3) That part of the north 1/2 of Legal Subdivision 13 of Section 18, Township 4, Range 27, West of the 6th Meridian, lying to the West of Plan A714.
- 4) That part of Legal Subdivision 16 of Section 13, Township 4, Range 28, West of the 6th Meridian, lying to the East of the east bank of a certain surveyed slough and to the West of Plan A714.
- 5) That part of Legal Subdivision 1 of Section 24, Township 4, Range 28, West of the 6th Meridian, lying East of a certain surveyed slough and West of Plan A714.
- 6) Those portions of fractional Legal Subdivision 11 of Section 19, Township 4, Range 27, West of the 6th Meridian, lying to the Northwest of Plan A718, except that part lying North of the most northerly channel of Wahleach Creek.

The whole containing approximately 8.5 hectares.

GABRIOLA SANDS PARK

Schedule

All those parcels or tracts of Crown land, together with all that foreshore or land covered by water situated in Nanaimo District, situated on Gabriola Island and lying within the following described boundaries:

Parcel "A"

1. Commencing at a point on the southwesterly high-water mark of Pilot Bay, said point being the intersection of the said high-water mark and the northeasterly prolongation of the northerly boundary of the area designated as "park" on the subdivision Plan 12655, deposited in the Victoria Land Registry Office, said park area lying adjacent to the northerly boundary of Lot 61, Section 21, Plan 12655;

thence northeasterly along the said prolongation a distance of 243.84 metres;

thence southeast $76^{\circ} 42'$ to a point, said point being on the northeasterly prolongation of the southerly boundary of Lot 1, Section 21, Plan 13612, deposited in the Victoria Land Registry Office;

thence southwesterly along the said prolongation to the high-water mark of Pilot Bay;

thence northwesterly along the said high-water mark to a point of commencement.

Parcel "B"

1. Lot 61 and 100 of Section 21, Plan 12655.
2. Lot 1 of Section 21, Plan 13612.
3. Those parts of Plan 12655 shown as "park" which lie between Lots 1 and 100, Plan 12655 and between Lots 60 and 61, Plan 12655.
4. Commencing at a point on the easterly high-water mark of Taylor Bay, said point being the intersection of the said high-water mark and the southwesterly prolongation of the northerly boundary of the area designated as "park" on subdivision plan 12655 deposited in the Victoria Land Registry Office, said park area lying adjacent to the northerly boundary of Lot 100, Section 21, Plan 12655;

thence southwesterly along the said prolongation a distance of 152.4 metres;

thence due South to a point being on the southwesterly prolongation of the southerly boundary of Lot 100, Section 21, Plan 12655;

thence northeasterly along the said prolongation to the easterly high-water mark of Taylor Bay;

thence in a northerly direction along the said high-water mark to the point of commencement.

The whole containing 5.3 ha more or less.

GREEN LAKE PARK - GREEN LAKE ISLANDS SITE

Schedule

All those parcels or tracts of Crown land, together with all that foreshore or land covered by water situated in Green Lake, Lillooet District and lying within the following described area:

unnamed islands, Ant Island, 1 Mile Island, Twin Islands, Proposition Island, Sand Island, Hat Island and Lot 3886.

The whole containing 119 hectares, more or less.

RAFT COVE PARK

Schedule

All those parcels or tracts of Crown land, together with all that foreshore or land covered by water, situated in Rupert District and lying within the following described boundaries:

Commencing at a point, said point being on the natural boundary of Vancouver Island, on the westerly shore thereof and being due West, a distance of 4.26 kilometres and due South, a distance of 3.14 kilometres, more or less, from the southwest corner of District Lot 1285;

thence in a straight line on a bearing of 45° to a point on the natural boundary of an unnamed creek, on the right bank thereof, said creek flowing southwesterly into Raft Cove;

thence in a northeasterly direction along the said natural boundary of the unnamed creek to a point thereon, said point being due West, a distance of 3.72 kilometre and due South, a distance of 2.60 kilometres, more or less, from the southwest corner of District Lot 1285;

thence on a bearing of 99°, a distance of 760 metres, more or less, to a point on the southerly watershed boundary of an unnamed creek, said unnamed creek flowing northeasterly into the most westerly tributary of Ronning Creek;

thence in a northeasterly direction along said southerly watershed boundary to a point thereon, said point being due West, a distance of 1.32 kilometres and due South, a distance of 2.48, more or less, from the southwest corner of District Lot 1285;

thence due South, a distance of 1.88 kilometres;

thence on a bearing of 218°, a distance of 1.50 kilometres;

thence in a straight line on a bearing of 257° to the natural boundary of Vancouver Island, on the westerly shore thereof;

thence in a northwesterly direction along said natural boundary to a point thereon, said point being the most westerly point on Commerell Point, Vancouver Island as shown on Crown Land Reference Map 102 I -059;

thence in a straight line, on a approximate bearing of 343°, to a point on the said natural boundary and said point forming the most northwesterly extent on the natural boundary of Raft Cave and said point being due West, a distance of 4.16 kilometres and due South, a distance of 3.26 kilometres, more or less, from the southwest corner of District Lot 1285;

thence in a northwest direction along the said natural boundary to the point of commencement.

The whole containing approximately 670 hectares (405 hectares uplands and 265 hectares foreshore).

RUGGED POINT MARINE PARK

Schedule

All those parcels or tracts of Crown land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water, situated in Rupert and Nootka Land Districts contained within the following described boundary:

Commencing at the northeast corner of District Lot 375, Nootka District and said northeast corner being on the natural boundary of Kyuquot Channel, Vancouver Island;

thence southerly along the easterly boundary of said District Lot 375 to a point thereon, said point being the most northerly northwest corner of District Lot 570, Rupert District;

thence easterly along the most northerly boundary of said District Lot 570, a distance of 500 metres;

thence due South 400 metres, more or less, to a point of intersection of the westerly prolongation of the most southerly north boundary of said District Lot 570;

thence easterly along the said westerly prolongation and the most southerly northerly boundary of said District Lot 570 to a point thereon, said point being due North of southwest corner of said District Lot 570;

thence due South to said southwesterly corner and said corner being on the natural boundary of the Vancouver Island;

thence due West, a distance of 200 metres;

thence in a northwesterly, northerly and northeasterly directions along a line drawn parallel to and 200 metres perpendicularly distant from said natural boundaries of Vancouver Island, two small unnamed islets and one large unnamed island lying southwest and west, respectively, from District Lot 375, Nootka District, to a point thereon, said point being due North of the northeast corner of said District Lot 375;

thence due South to said northeast corner of District Lot 375, Nootka District and being the point of commencement.

The whole containing 308 hectares, mores or less (158 hectares of upland and 150 hectares of foreshore).

SHANNON FALLS PARK

Schedule

All those Crown parcels or tracts of land, together with all that foreshore or land covered by water, situated in Group 1, New Westminster District, and lying within the following described boundaries:

- 1) Parcel B of District Lot 608, Reference Plan 899.
- 2) That part of Parcel C of District Lot 608, lying east of Garibaldi Highway, shown on Explanatory Plan 7565.
- 3) That part of Block E of District Lot 608, Plan 10467, lying south of a line being 77 metres north of the southwest corner of District Lot 2177, thence Northwesterly 276 degrees a distance of 202 metres from the west boundary of said lot.
- 4) Parcel H of District Lot 608, Explanatory Plan 7565, except Plan H-133.
- 5) District Lot 3538, except plans 10597, 20152 and H-133.

The whole containing approximately 87 hectares.

TAYLOR ARM PARK

Schedule

All Crown parcels or tracts of land, together with all that foreshore or land covered by water, situated in Clayoquot Land District contained within the following described boundaries:

District Lots 2089 and 2091, save and except Alberni-Tofino Highway #4 as identified on Right-of-Way Plan 2750.

The whole containing approximately 71 hectares.
