- ✓ (a) Kettle River Rec. Area, established by order in council 2613/72 is cancelled and the Crown land described in Schedule 1 is re-established as a provincial recreation area and the name of which is declared to be Kettle River Recreation Area;
- ✓ (b) Stone Mountain Park, re-established by B.C. Reg. 164/80 is cancelled and the Crown land in Schedule 2 is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name of which is declared to be Stone Mountain Park;
- ✓ (c) Conkle Lake Park established by order in council 891/73 is cancelled and the Crown land in Schedule 3 is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name of which is declared to be Conkle Lake Park;
- ✓ (d) Burton Site of Arrow Lakes Park, established by order in council 1097/81 be cancelled and the Crown land in Schedule 4 is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name of which is declared to be Arrow Lakes Park, Burton Site;
- ✓ (e) Elko Park, established by order in council 2775/58 is cancelled and the Crown land in Schedule 5 is re-established as a Class "C" Provincial Park and the name of which is declared to be Elko Park;
- ✓ (f) Beaver Creek Park, established by order in council 829/65 is cancelled and the Crown land in Schedule 6 is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name of which is declared to be Beaver Creek Park;
- ✓ (g) Inkaneep Park, established by order in council 532/56 is cancelled and the Crown land in Schedule 7 is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name of which is declared to be Inkaneep Park;
- ✓ (h) Ruth Lake Park, re-established by order in council 583/79 is cancelled and the Crown land in Schedule 8 is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name of which is declared to be Ruth Lake Park;
- ✓ (i) Crow's Nest Park, re-established by order in council 2281/82 is cancelled and the Crown land in Schedule 9 is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name of which is declared to be Crowsnest Park;
- ✓ (j) The Parks Branch be authorized to manage and administer, and the Park Act Regulations shall apply to a 40 metre wide trail which lies within a corridor described in Schedule 10 as an access to Monashee Park;
- ✓ (k) Whereas the Federal Government has transferred property listed in Schedule 11 under authority of Privy Council 1962-1213 and Privy Council 1972-1548 for park purposes, the Minister of Lands, Parks and Housing be authorized to accept the property;
- ✓ (l) Roserim Creek Park, established by order in council 1532/60, is cancelled;
- ✓ (m) Snootli Creek Park, established by order in council 4059/68 and amended by order in council 766/76, is cancelled.
