The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council 1105, approved September 18th, 1937, notice of which appeared in the British Columbia Gazette of September 23rd, 1937, the following described area was reserved and set apart for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public:

All those lands, and lands covered by water, comprising the strip of foreshore which lies to the south of the Oyster River, and which fronts on the following surveyed areas, namely, the fractional northwest 1/4 of Section 3 and fractional Sections 8, 9 and 17, Township 5, and Lot 221 (South of River) Comox Land District.

THAT certain of these lands, fronting on Miracle Beach Park, have now been surveyed and designated Lot 283 Nanaimo Land District.

THAT in order to exercise necessary control of the use of Lot 283 Nanaimo, it is desirable that the said Lot be administered as park land under the provisions of the "Forest Act":

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT in accordance with the provisions of Section 96 of the "Land Act," being Chapter 175, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, Order-in-Council 1105, approved September 18th, 1937, be cancelled insofar as it affects Lot 283, Nanaimo Land District.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT in accordance with the provisions of Section 128 of the "Forest Act," being Chapter 128, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the said Lot 283 be added to Miracle Beach Park. (1)

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT a certified copy of this minute, if approved, be forwarded to the Superintendent of Lands, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C.
