The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report: *see % 1966/63 & 1709/66, 131/67, 546/80*

THAT the following described lands have been donated to Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of British Columbia for park purposes.

1. Parcel "A", Section 1, Range 2 East, North Saltspring Island, Cowichan District, except Plan 9961, containing 20.8 acres more or less.
2. That part of Section 1, Range 3 East, North Saltspring Island, Cowichan District, lying to the West of the Westerly boundary of Plan 6344 and to the South of the Southerly boundary of Plan 1371, containing 30 acres more or less.
3. Lot 9 of Section 1, Range 4 East and Lots 21 and 23 of Section 1, Ranges 3 and 4 East, North Saltspring Island, Cowichan District, Plan 3321, containing 2.25 acres more or less.
4. Lots 1 to 16 inclusive and Lot 22, Section 1, Range 3 East, North Saltspring Island, Cowichan District, Plan 6344, except those parts of Lots 6, 7 and 8 lying to the North of a boundary parallel to and perpendicularly distant 2.141 chains from the Northerly boundaries of each of the said Lots 6, 7 and 8 and containing 5.88 acres more or less.

AND THAT all of the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, all of the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class 'A' to be known as Mouat Park.
