THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 586, approved March 18, 1957, the following described lands were reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public.


Lots 8001 and 8002 Lillooet Land District containing 11.81 acres more or less.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.


AND TO RECOMMEND THAT Order-in-Council No. 586, approved March 18, 1957, be cancelled.
