The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the following described lands were reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public by Order-in-Council No. 1605, approved July 14th, 1948:

"That part of Lot 1025 Kootenay District, lying east of the right-of-way of the Kootenay and Arrowhead Railway as shown coloured red on Plan 674P and south of Parcel assigned Letter "A" of Parcel No. 1 as shown on Explanatory Plan 169621, containing 28.8 acres more or less."

THAT the Lardeau Centennial Committee and other local agencies have urged the establishment of a Provincial park in the vicinity of Lardeau.

AND THAT the above-described lands have been examined and found to be suitable for development as a community park.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 13 of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act" the above-described lands be constituted a Provincial park known as "Lardeau Provincial Park."

AND TO RECOMMEND FURTHER THAT the said Lardeau Provincial Park be of Class "C".

AND TO RECOMMEND FURTHER THAT a certified copy of this minute, if approved, be forwarded to the Superintendent of Lands, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C.
