The undersigned has the honour to report:

AMN 9/6 3/16/65

THAT the following described vacant Crown lands have been examined and found to be very valuable for public recreation:

Commencing at the most Westerly corner of Lot 3376^B, S.D.Y.D., thence West 40 chains; thence North 30 chains, more or less to the Southerly limit of the public road right-of-way between Penticton and Hedley; thence in an Easterly direction along the said Southerly limit to a point due North of the most Westerly Northwest corner of Lot 2964, S.D.Y.D., thence South 51 chains, thence West 134 chains, thence North 30 chains more or less to the point of commencement.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of the provisions of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as APEX MOUNTAIN PARK.


