THAT the following described lands have been donated to the Crown in right of the Province for park purposes:

Section 78; the East Half of Section 115; and the East Half of Section 116, Lake District, as shown coloured Red on Crown Grant deposited under 33203-1, except that part thereof shown outlined in Red on Plan 365 B.L., all comprising 162.7 acres more or less.

AND THAT these lands now require management under the provisions of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act and Regulations thereunder.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class 'C' to be known as "Thomas S. Francis Park."




