THAT the North Peace Historical Society is desirous of developing a park and museum of local history on the following described area on the Peace River:

Unsurveyed Island in Sections 25 and 26, and fractional L.S. 4 of Section 25, all in Township 82, Range 18, W6M, containing 102 acres, more or less.

AND THAT the site is considered suitable for the purposes outlined by the Society.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under provisions of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Peace Island Provincial Park.
