The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 271 approved March 12, 1930, Lots 594 and 596 Group 2, New Westminster District, situated at White Rock, B.C. were reserved and set apart for park purposes under the provision of the Provincial Parks Act, being Chapter 189, R.S.B.C. 1924,

THAT in accordance with the provisions of Section 142, of the Forest Act as enacted by the Forest Act amendment Acts of 1939 and 1940, White Rock Park was classified as a Provincial park Class "C".


THAT an application has been made by the Corporation of the Municipality of Surrey to acquire the said Park.

THAT it is considered in the public interest to place the park under the control of the Corporation and issue lease for a term of twenty-one years at a nominal rental of \$1.00 per annum


AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of Section 127 of the Forest Act the reservation of Lots 594 and 596, Group 2, New Westminster District for Park purposes be cancelled.


AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of clause (c) of Section 82 of the Land Act, Chapter 144, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936, a lease be issued in favour of the Corporation of the Municipality of Surrey for a period of twenty-one years covering lots 594 and 596, Group 2, New Westminster District, at a nominal rental of \$1.00 per annum.
