To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council: 1775/83

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the following described vacant Crown land, situated at One Mile Lake in Pemberton Valley, is held under a Departmental Map Reserve for public recreational use:

"Those portions of Lots 203, 259 and 239, Lillooet Land District, more particularly described as follows: commencing at the south-west corner of Lot 203; thence north 1530' along the west boundary of said Lot 203; thence east 2640'; thence south 2450'; thence west 2640'; thence north 920', more or less, to the point of commencement, containing approximately 75 acres."

AND THAT representations from local organizations have urged establishment of a Provincial park to permit management under Park Regulations.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park use.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act the above described lands be constituted a Provincial park of Class 'C' to be known as "Pemberton Park".
