The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT certain vacant Crown lands bordering on the Cheam section of the Trans-Canada Highway, have been examined and found suitable for the development of a Provincial Park.

THAT for the purpose of this instrument the said lands may be described as follows:

That portion of the northwest quarter of Section 30, Township 29, New Westminster Land District, lying south of the southerly limit of the right-of-way of the Trans-Canada Highway, containing 13 acres more or less.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 13 of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act," being Chapter 53, Statutes of British Columbia, 1957, the said lands be constituted a Provincial Park to be known as "Meadowland Park."

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 14 of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act," being Chapter 53, Statutes of British Columbia, 1957, the said Meadowland Park shall be of Class "A".

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT a certified copy of this Minute, if approved, be forwarded to the Superintendent of Lands, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C.
