The undersigned has the honour to Report:

THAT the following described lands have been reserved for the use, recreation, and enjoyment of the public.

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 5698, New Westminster District, being on the edge - of-the-bed of Haslam Lake; thence west along the north boundary of Lot 5698 to the northwest corner thereof; thence west 10 chains; thence north 3 chains; thence west 8 chains; thence north 5 chains more or less to the edge-of-the-bed of Haslam Lake; thence easterly and southerly along the said edge-of-the-bed to the point of commencement and containing approximately 40 acres, subject however, to Conditional Water Licence No. 24036.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as "Haslam Lake Provincial Park".
