Lots 56, 57, 58, 59 and 60 of District Lot 30, Kootenay District; Lot 17, Kootenay District; and the most northerly 3260 feet of District Lot 31, Kootenay District, lying east of the southern Trans-Provincial Highway and northeast of Plan 2161, Kootenay District and containing approximately 290 acres.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Elizabeth Lake Provincial Park.
