THAT Order-in-Council No. 1291, approved May 11, 1961, established a Provincial Park of Class 'C' to be known as Gardom Lake Park. 2668/78,

AND THAT the said Order-in-Council cancelled Order-in-Council No. 37, approved January 6, 1945.

AND THAT certain lands which were reserved by Order-in-Council No. 37, approved January 6, 1945, were not included within Order-in-Council No. 1291, approved May 11, 1961.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT the boundaries of Gardom Lake Park be extended to include these lands which are described as follows:

Part of an unsurveyed Island in Gardom Lake being part of Fractional Legal Subdivision 13 of Section 9, Township 19, Range 9, West of the Sixth Meridian.
