THAT the following described lands have been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public by Order-in-Council Number 2603, approved November 20, 1959.

"All that parcel or tract of land situated in Lots 1560 and 2117, Peace River District, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the southerly limit of the Alaska Highway as shown on Plan H543 on file in the Land Registry Office, Kamloops, with the westerly limit of an unnamed road lying to the west of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, Block A, Plan 9685; thence south 0°10'30" west, a distance of 725.99 feet along the said westerly limit of the unnamed road to the northerly limit of an unnamed road which lies north of Block G of Lot 2117, Plan 9685; thence westerly along the said northerly limit of the unnamed road, a distance of 780 feet; thence due north to the aforesaid southerly limit of the Alaska Highway, Plan H543; thence easterly along the said southerly limit of the Alaska Highway to the point of commencement and containing 13 acres."

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT Order-in-Council Number 2603, approved November 20, 1959, be cancelled.

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a provincial park of Class "C" to be known as Fort Nelson Centennial Park.
