The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT under the provisions of Section 25 of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act," Lot "A", Section 11, Pender Island, Cowichan District Plan 11907, containing 39.32 acres, was acquired by gift for Provincial park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of Section 13 of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act," being Chapter 53, Statutes of British Columbia 1957, the said Lot "A" be constituted a Provincial Park to be known as Prior Centennial Park and, that under the provisions of Section 14 of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act," being Chapter 53, Statutes of British Columbia, 1957, said Prior Centennial Park shall be of Class "A".
