The undersigned has the honour to report:

RES. 2674/80

THAT the following described lands have been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public.

That portion of the south 35 chains of Lot 883, Kootenay District, lying to the west of a line drawn parallel to and perpendicularly distant 50 feet from the centre line of Provincial Highway No. 3 and containing 14 acres more or less.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under provisions of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class 'A' to be known as Kuskonook Park.
