THAT residents of Blue River have requested that the following described lands be designated a Provincial park:

"That portion of Lot 3285, K.D.Y.D., lying South of Blue River and West of the public road, containing 60 acres more or less."

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act the above described lands be constituted a Provincial park of Class "C" to be known as Blue River Park, subject to the provisions of the Water Act.


