To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the following described lands were acquired by the Crown Provincial for highway purposes:

That part of Lot G Plan 5261 lying north of the right-of-way of the Othello Road,

and

Lot P, Plan 5261 save and except thereout the right-of-way of the Othello Road,

and

Lot O, Plan 5261, save and except Plan 9317 and the right-of-way of the Othello Road.

All of Section 11, Township 5, Range 26, W6M and containing 14.4 acres more or less.

AND THAT the above described lands are no longer needed for highway purposes;

AND THAT the above described Crown lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes;

AND THAT the Department of Highways has indicated a willingness to transfer the administration and control of the above lands to the Department of Recreation and Conservation;

AND THAT the following described Crown foreshore and land covered by water has been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public:


Commencing at a point on the high water mark of Kawkawa Lake, said point being the northeast corner of the area shown as "Park" on Subdivision Plan 9082, deposited in the Land Registry Office, Kamloops; thence east 200 feet; thence in a straight line to the most easterly intersection of the north boundary of Legal Subdivision 15, Section 11, Township 5, Range 26, W6M, and the high water mark of Kawkawa Lake; thence southerly, westerly and northerly along said high water mark to the point of commencement and containing 0.9 acre more or less.

AND THAT a 0.958 acre parcel of fractional Legal Subdivisions 2 and 3 of Section 14, Township 5, Range 26, W6M, Y.D.Y.D., has been designated as "Park" on Plan of Subdivision 9082 deposited in the Land Registry Office, Kamloops.

AND THAT the Registrar, Kamloops Land Registry Office, has given his consent to the said park being administered and developed under the authority of the "Park Act".

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT all of the above described Crown lands and foreshore be established as a Provincial park of Class A, Category 4 to be known as Kawkawa Lake Park.
