The undersigned has the honour to Report:

THAT the following described lands are held in the name of the Crown Provincial for park purposes.

Those portions of Section 13, Range 1, West, and Sections 12 and 13, Range 1, East, Sidney Island, Cowichan Land District, as shown on plan Number D.D. 12075^I deposited in the Land Registry Office, Victoria, save and except those portions held by the Department of Transport shown on plan 537^R deposited in the Land Registry Office, Victoria and on unregistered plans 2 T 461 and 10 T 427 as deposited in the Lands Branch vault and containing 160 acres more or less.

and

That portion of Section 13, Range 1, East, Sidney Island, Cowichan Land District known as Lot A and designated as a public park on plan 3854 deposited in the Land Registry Office, Victoria, and containing 3.2 acres.

AND THAT the following described foreshore was reserved by Order-in-Council No. 1497[✓] approved June 29th, 1954 for park purposes.

All that area of foreshore lying below average high-water-mark, known as the Sidney Lagoon situated at the Northerly end of Sidney or Sallas Island, Cowichan Land District, and lying between Sections 13 and 14 of the said Sidney Island, save and except the right-of-way of the Department of Transport submarine power transmission line which crosses the said area, and containing 374 acres more or less.


AND THAT all of the above described lands and foreshore have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT, Order-in-Council No. 1497[✓], approved June 29, 1954, be cancelled.


