On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that


Barkerville Historic Park, established by Order in Council 26/59 is cancelled and the Crown land in the Barkerville Schedule is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name is declared to be Barkerville Park;

Kilby Historic Park, established by Order in Council 2919/73 is cancelled and the Crown land in the Kilby Schedule is re-established as a Class "A" Provincial Park and the name is declared to be Kilby Park;

Blessing's Grave Historic Park, established by Order in Council 234/73 is cancelled;

Fort Steele Historic Park, re-established by Order in Council 1776/83, is cancelled.
