The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT through the generosity of Mr. Geoffrey Newstead, Royal Oak P.O., B.C. title to that parcel of land, being in the Victoria Assessment District and more particularly described as Lot Two (2), Section Ninety-Two (92), Esquimalt District, according to a map or plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of Victoria, Province of British Columbia, under Plan Number 7398, has been transferred to the Province of British Columbia for the use and enjoyment of the public as a Provincial Park.

AND FURTHER TO REPORT THAT Mr. Geoffrey Newstead has requested that the said Provincial Park be given the name of "NEWSTEAD PARK."


AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of Section 128 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128, Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, and subsequent amendments, the said parcel of land, being in the Victoria Assessment District and more particularly described as Lot Two (2), Section Ninety-Two (92), Esquimalt District, according to a map or plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of Victoria, Province of British Columbia, under Plan Number 7398, be constituted a Provincial Park for the pleasure and recreation of the public, to be known as "NEWSTEAD PROVINCIAL PARK."

AND THAT under authority of Section 129 of the Forest Act being Chapter 128, Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948 and subsequent amendments, the said Park be classified as a Provincial Park of Class "C".
