The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT a certain portion of land in the vicinity of Kelowna was designated as park land on Subdivision Plan 4740, Section 23, Township 26, O.D.Y.D., deposited in the Land Registry Office, Kamloops, B.C.

THAT there is considerable local interest in developing and administering this area as a community park.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, that portion of Section 23, Township 26, O.D.Y.D., shown as "park" on Plan 4740 deposited in the Land Registry Office, Kamloops, and containing 3.73 acres more or less, be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Rutland Community Park.
