The undersigned has the honour to recommend:

470/76

THAT under authority of Section 96 of the "Land Act," being Chapter 175, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the reserve covering the following described areas established pursuant to Orders-in-Council No. 922 approved May 13, 1947, and No. 2305, approved October 20, 1949 respectively, be cancelled:

(a) "Lot 8936, Cariboo Land District, containing 50.8 acres,"

and

(b) "The East half of the Northeast quarter of Lot 8940, Cariboo Land District, containing 20 acres, more or less."

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 128 of the "Forest Act," Chapter 128, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948 and Amendments, the following described lands be constituted a Provincial Park for the pleasure and recreation of the public to be known as "McBride Community Park."

"Lot 8936 and the east half of the northeast quarter of Lot 8940, Cariboo Land District, containing 70.8 acres, more or less."

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 129 of the "Forest Act," Chapter 128, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948 and Amendments, the said park be classified as a Provincial Park of Class "C".

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT a certified copy of this minute, if approved, be forwarded to the Superintendent of Lands, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C.

**MEMO**
